Dear Parents and Students:

We are quickly approaching the administration dates of the state assessments including the MSTEP for students in grades 6 and 7, and PSAT 8 and MSTEP for students in grade 8.

On April 9, 2019, the PSAT 8 will be administered to all students in grade 8. Due to the nature of the testing, all 8<sup>th</sup> graders will report to their home school at their normal start time of 7:51AM. The 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders will follow a **delayed** start schedule and will report at 11:00AM. There will be no breakfast or morning classes for 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders.

### Grade 6 & 7

- Report at 11:00AM – Transportation available and delayed by 3 hours and 15 minutes
  - Calculate pick up time by adding 3 hours and 15 minutes to **current** bus stop time
- 11:00AM-2:46PM normal schedule (Hours 4, 5, 6)
- Lunch served at school

### Grade 8

- Report at regular start time
- 8:00AM-11:00AM PSAT 8 testing window
- 11:00AM-2:46PM normal schedule (Hours 4, 5, 6)
- Lunch served at school

### MS2TC

- AM classes will NOT be held at MS2TC
- 8th graders report to home school at regular start time
- 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders report to home school at 11:00AM

Please note: Proctoring regulations do not permit interruptions during the PSAT assessment; therefore, please make all arrangements for 8<sup>th</sup> graders prior to the start of the school day on April 9, 2019.
