



Halloween Costume Rules/Guidelines



- Students may wear Halloween costumes to school on **Tuesday, October 31, 2017.**
- The Booster Club's Halloween Extravaganza is after school on **Thursday, October 26, 2017** from **3 – 4:30pm.**
- No clown outfits
- School rules regarding the dress code must be followed. No short skirts/tutus or short shorts, no bare midriffs, no bare shoulders, or low necklines, nothing that promotes the use of illegal substances or activities or are derogatory or disrespectful or depict violence.
- All costume preparations are to be completed at home. (No dressing or applying of make-up or colored hairspray once students arrive at school.)
- No masks or weapons.
- Students who have questions about the acceptability of their costume should check with the office prior to wearing the costume to school.
- Students wearing **inappropriate** costumes will be sent to the office to call home for a change of clothes.
