BUS STUDENTS**

**How is transportation arranged?**

Through the MMSTC Office.

**Will there be a bus stop to Mott, Cousino and SHHS?**

Yes.

**If I live in one school area but my child will be attending another WCS school as school of choice, how will it affect transportation?**

If a student is school of choice within WCS, there will always be transportation to their home school. For example, if a student lives in the Mott area, but will be attending SHHS as school of choice, we will transport that student to Mott. There will not be a bus to their home. We always provide transportation directly to our 3 high schools after our PM session.

**Will there be a bus stop to my home area?**

Yes, check the transportation list posted on the MMSTC website under "Opening Packet". The transportation list will be posted by the third week of August.

**What time does the bus leave Mott, Cousino, and SHHS?**

Check the individual home school bus shuttle posting at MMSTC and at the home school, the third week of August.

**Will there be different busses for route stops and school stops (Mott, Cousino, or SHHS?)**

Probably, check the posting on the MMSTC website. In previous years, there was not a bus to the Mott homes. WCS provides one bus for Mott students directly to Mott. Those Mott students needing transportation to their homes disembark at Mott and catch the appropriate bus home. Check Mott for the home stop and bus numbers before school begins.

**How many days will a bus stop stay active?**

After three no shows, the bus stop will be eliminated.

**If my bus needs change from week to week or day to day, whom do I communicate with?**

Your child needs to communicate with each of the bus drivers involved.

**How does my child resume the bus stop?**

By calling WCS Trans Dept. at **(586)698-4443** between the hours 5:30 am and 2:00 pm. Please state bus number and bus stop.

**When I see the bus list posted on the website, if my child's home bus stop is not scheduled whom do I call?**
